### Family Photos: Reworked

Overview:

Two photographers present striking images, reworking and reinventing their family photographs.

Using pin-hole cameras and montages of new and old family photos, Anne-Marie Glasheen re-creates images of three generations of her mother's family. She comments "Family photos provide answers, but throw up questions. They hold keys, and they hide secrets."

John Levett is also inspired by uncertain personal histories; his series is an exercise in reconstruction. Writing a postmemory of his life, he recalled half-facts; created fictions; made up family romances; reshot the pictures—under glare, in shadow, through reflection; formally and casually; in new frames and blu-tacked onto a mirror.
